Between 2006 and 2010:

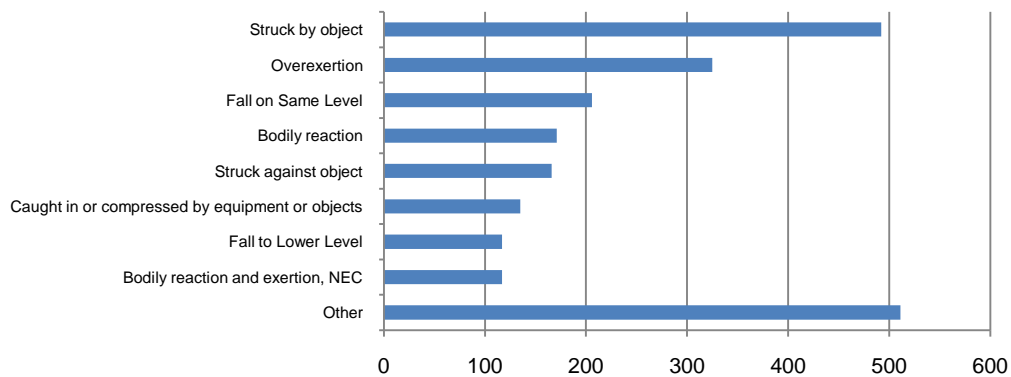
- 5% of young worker time loss claims were in the North Region
- 71% of young workers time loss claims accepted between 2006 and 2010 related to males
- \$24,525,000 in claim costs and 63,000 days were paid relating to young worker time loss claims in the North Region.

Top Accident Types (2006 - 2010)



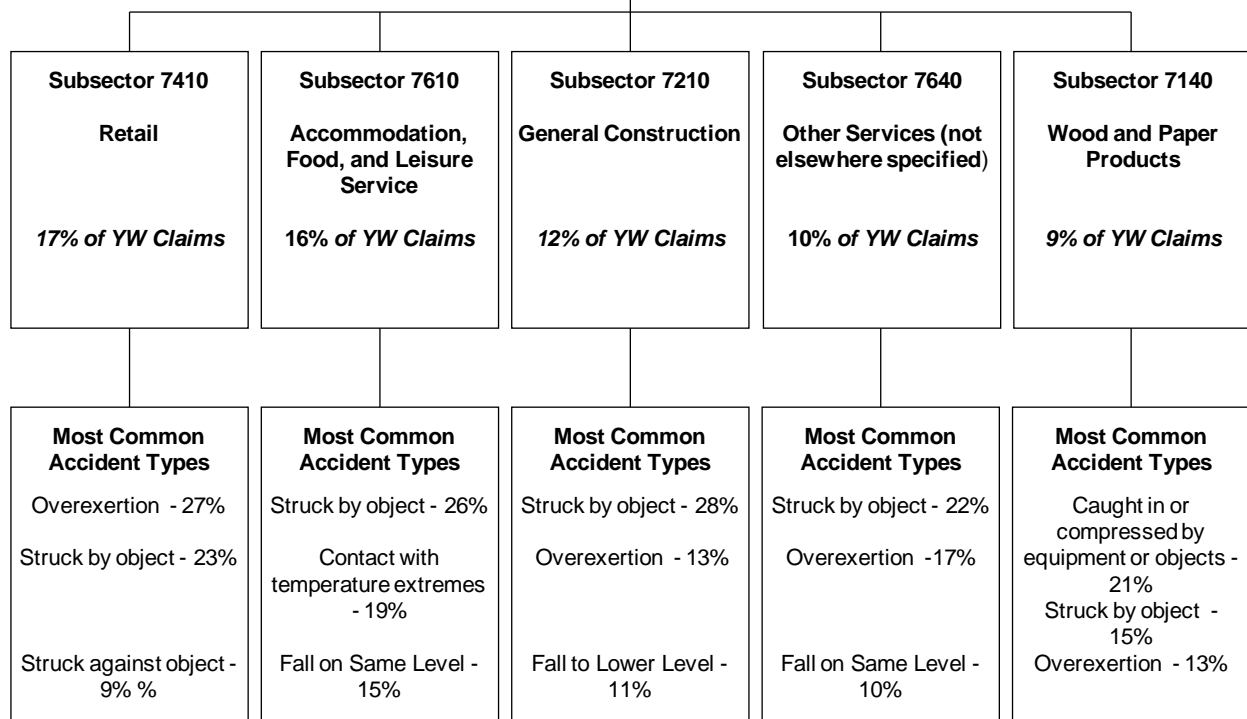
Body Part Injured (2006 - 2010)

Within the Most Common Accident Types shown above:

- “Struck By” represents specific accident types that include “Struck by Falling Object” and “Struck by Slipping Handheld Object”, among others.
- “Overexertion” represents specific accident types that include “Overexertion in Lifting” and “Overexertion in Pulling, Pushing Objects”, among others.
- “Fall from Elevation” represents specific accident types that include “Fall/Jump to Lower Level, NEC” and “Fall from Ladder/Steps & Stairs”, among others.

Notes and Definitions

- Time-Loss Claim volumes: based on STD/LTD/Fatal (SLF) Claims - STD/LTD/FTL Claims represent claims with a first short-term disability, long-term disability or fatal benefit (reserve set or cash award) paid in the period, regardless of the year of injury.
- Region: There were some data quality issues with claim coding for operating locations of reporting employers for 2009 claims, in particular in May-July of 2009.
- Claim Costs Paid: Claim Costs paid for Young Worker SLF Claims in the period, regardless of year of injury.
- Days Lost: Work Days Lost reflects total short term disability (STD) days paid in the year regardless of year of injury.
- Percentages of claims for accident types and injury types are based on coded claims.
- Subsectors shown above are the top 5 based on a ranking of young worker time-loss claims volume between 2006 and 2010 for the region.
